- Unpack, rest & relax

DAY 3 - JAFFA & TEL AVIV (GUIDE & TRANSPORTATION) Tuesday - October 28, 2025

- Lunch on own at Carmel Market

 - Enjoy walking through the beautiful Yemin Moshe neighborhood & Montefiore's Windmill
 - Explore the Christian Quarter including the Via Dolorosa & Church of the Holy Sepulcher
- Musical havdallah
- Dinner on own
- Included evening activity: Watch the Sound-&-Light Spectacular screened on the walls of the Tower of David. (Show is outdoors. Please dress warmly & ensure to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start.)

DAY 8 - OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM (GUIDE & TRANSPORTATION) Sunday - November 2, 2025

- Introduction to Old City of Jerusalem at the impressive Jaffa Gate
- Sights & sounds of the historic Jewish Quarter including the Cardo, Broad Wall, Batei Machase & more
- Lunch in Jewish Quarter on own
- Time for reflection at the Western Wall
- Walk in the footsteps of Prophets and Kings in the City of David; feel the Bible come to life!
- Return to hotel; Hear from renowned author Yossi Klein Halevi about life in Jerusalem and living side by side the Arab community
- Dinner on own

DAY 9 - JUDEAN DESERT (GUIDE & TRANSPORTATION) Monday - November 3, 2025

- Don't forget towels, bathing suit, water, hats and sun screen!
- Explore the beautiful desert oasis of Ein Gedi where David fled from King Saul and cool off under a waterfall
- Ascend (via cable car) the formidable desert fortress of Masada where the Zealots contested the might of the Roman Empire
- Lunch on own at Masada foodcourt
- Boat along the Dead Sea, the lowest place on Earth, and discover its unique salt and crystal formations that can be seen only from this vantage-point
- Enjoy a delicious dinner at Cna'anit restaurant overlooking the expansive Judean desert
- Return to Jerusalem

DAY 10 - YAD VASHEM & HAR HERZL, NATIONAL LIBRARY (GUIDE & TRANSPORTATION)

Tuesday - November 4, 2025

- Pay tribute to the memory of the Six Million at the Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum & Children's Memorial. (Please note: minimum age for entry into the museum is 10 years old).
- Encounter the leaders and heroes who are interred at the Mount Herzl National Cemetery
- For lunch, enjoy a mouth-watering culinary tour in the colorful Machane Yehudah Outdoor Market
- Afternoon at leisure for shopping time

DAY 11 - GAZA ENVELOPE (GUIDE & TRANSPORTATION) Wednesday - November 5, 2025

- Meet with local residents at a kibbutz or moshav along the Gaza border who share their pre- and post-October 7 experiences

- Lunch at Salad Trail (included)
- Pay tribute to the many young people lost at the NOVA dance festival site on Oct 7 and meet with a survivor of the attack

- Visit the Underground Bullet Factory at Machon Ayalon where the Haganah secretly manufactured ammunition under the noses of the British prior to Independence.
- Learn to appreciate your senses having a tasty meal in the dark at the Blackout Restaurant at Jaffa's unique Na Laga'at Center
- Time for last minute shopping
- Farewell dinner at Regina Restaurant
- Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for your flight home
